The percentage of pupils who achieved expected outcomes in Reading, Writing, and Maths was 71/75% (64% nationally.)

For <u>disadvantaged pupils</u> 50% (67%) achieved expected outcomes in Reading, Writing and Maths.

Progress measures for NMPS pupils compared with National data:

Reading progress; KS2 progress in reading was significantly above national average and in the highest 20% of all schools in 2019. The 3 Year average reading attainment scores are in the highest 20%.

Writing progress; KS2 progress in writing was average compared with all schools nationally.

Maths progress; KS2 progress in maths was significantly above national average and in the highest 20% of all schools in 2019.
