Dear Parents, Welcome to the Summer Term. I hope you enjoyed the lovely weather over our Easter break. Let's hope that wasn't our summer! Our topic this term is **ANCIENT CIVILISATIONS**. Within this, our history focus (after half-term) will be the Ancient Egyptians.

We will be going on a trip to Liverpool Museum - more details below. Our Science focus will be Electricity. We will be building circuits and testing for conductivity.

Our drumming lessons will continue on Thursday mornings. Samba is very different to the Djembe drums, and also a lot louder! If your child wants to wear ear defenders for these sessions, please make sure they have them on Thursdays. There will be another opportunity to see (and hear) their playing - I'll let you know the date as soon as it is in the diary.

I will be taking the children to Liverpool Museum on <u>Tuesday 17th June</u>. We will have time to explore the Ancient Egyptian gallery as well as taking part in two workshops led by museum staff. I have done this trip before and the workshops have been excellent .There will be a charge for this trip - I am using our class donation from the PTA towards the cost but coaches are very expensive. More details about cost will be sent from Miss Moody soon.

Just a reminder that all Year 4 children across the country take part in a Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) in June. The purpose of the MTC is to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently, which is essential for future success in mathematics. Regular practice using the website and apps recommended will help prepare your child for this.
