LAST TERM!

I can't believe we are in the last term, this year has gone so quick! I am feeling very sad about saying goodbye to the children after teaching them for two years. I have had the best two years getting to know every single one of them and I am so proud of all the progress they have made!

TOPICS

In Maths this term, we are going to be looking at coin recognition, position and direction and time. Our History topic this term is continuing with 'School Days'. Children will be comparing schooling in the Victorian era to their experiences today. For Science, we are looking at 'Seasonal Changes'. Children will learn about seasonal changes and typical seasonal weather and events. In PSHE, we are looking at 'Changing Me'. This term we will be covering the topic of relationships and growing up. We will be learning the correct names of our body parts (vulva, vagina, penis, testicles and anus). We will learn about how the parts of our body covered by our underwear are private and that our privacy should be respected. We will learn about growing from young to old and how our needs change.
