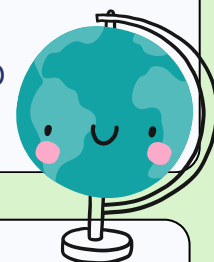

Classroom Highlights

Literacy

In reading we're focussing on blending sounds to read words, and begin to read short sentences. In writing we're focussing on letter formation as well as writing words and phrases using our phonics knowledge. We're also learning to retell stories using story maps.

Maths

This term in our mastering number lessons we're learning to subitise to 5, find 1 more and 1 less, explore the composition of numbers within 10 and compare quantities. In our space, shape and measure lessons we're exploring mass, capacity, length and 3D shapes

Wider curriculum

Our key themes and topics this term are: Winter, animals in hot and cold places, superheroes, people that help us and lunar new year.

Homework

The children's sound grids have been updated in their homework books. Please continue to focus on the sounds not highlighted.
