Dear All,

Welcome back! Happy New Year! I hope everyone is well and enjoyed a lovely break. This newsletter provides information for you for this term and gives you information about what your child will be learning in the next term in Year Three.

Mrs Kelly will be working in Year 3 this term, along with Miss McCallion on a Monday afternoon and Mr McCance on a Wednesday morning. If you have any questions about this newsletter or anything else, and you can't see me personally please feel free to message me on Class Dojo or email me.

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Topic This term our topic is called 'Rocks, Relics and Rumbles'. It will be a geography-based topic. This project teaches children about the features and characteristics of Earth's layers, including a detailed exploration of volcanic, tectonic and seismic activity. This topic will cover many other areas of the curriculum, it has mini topics which run alongside it. These include art and design topics based around fossils, learning about sketching, print work and sculpture. We will also do a study of the artist L.S Lowry. In science this term the children will learn about contact and non-contact forces, including friction and magnetism. They investigate frictional and magnetic forces, and identify parts of a magnet and magnetic materials.

Class Dojo – It looks like all the parents are connected on Class Dojo. I will continue to use this platform to keep in regular contact and share the things we're getting up to in Year 3.

PE – days for PE this term will be Wednesday with Mr McCance.
