Welcome to the second half of the Spring Term! It is going to be a busy one for Year 4. Along with Year 3, we hope that our performance of **Porridge** will entertain you in the week before we finish for Easter! I would like to give you prior notice of two trips that I have planned for June (23rd). One is to Liverpool World Museum and will support our work on the Ancient Egyptians. We will travel on a coach which is an expensive mode of transport. I am in the process of calculating the cost and will let you know as soon as I can. The second is to Buxton to a music event called Count Me In (16th) where the children will be playing their instruments with an orchestra. I'd like to travel by train as it will be so much cheaper but I will need someone to transport the larger instruments...watch this space!

Our performance of **Porridge** will take place on **Tuesday 24th (6pm)** and **Wednesday 25th (2pm)** March in the school hall. Requests for help with costumes will be coming home very soon and any help you can give your child to learn scripts and song words would be much appreciated.

Just a reminder that all Year 4 children across the country take part in a Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) in June. The purpose of the MTC is to determine whether pupils can recall their times tables fluently, which is essential for future success in mathematics. Regular practice using the website and apps recommended will help prepare your child for this.
