Welcome Back



I hope you all had a wonderful week off. I can't quite believe we are in the last term, this year has gone by so quick! It is going to be very difficult to say goodbye to the children after teaching them for so long. It has been such a joy to get to know each and every one of them, and I am incredibly proud of all the progress they have made during our time together.

What We Are Learning



In Maths this term, we will be learning about coin recognition, position and direction, and time.

Our Geography topic is Bright Lights, Big City, where the children will build on their knowledge of the physical and human features of the United Kingdom, with a particular focus on the characteristics of London as the capital city.

In Science, we will be exploring Seasonal Changes. The children will learn about the changes that happen across the seasons, including typical weather patterns and seasonal events.

In PSHE, our topic is Changing Me. We will be learning about relationships, growing up, and how our bodies change as we get older. The children will learn the correct names for body parts (vulva, vagina, penis, testicles and anus), understand that the areas covered by underwear are private, and discuss the importance of privacy and respect. We will also explore how people grow and how their needs change over time.
