PSHE

This half term we will be covering the topic of relationships and growing up. We will be learning the correct names of our body parts. (Vulva, vagina, penis, testicles and anus.) We will learn about how the parts of our body covered by our underwear are private and that our privacy should be respected. We will learn about the ways we are unique, the same or different to others and the different types of families there are. We will also learn about how and who to tell if they are worried or scared about something. We will learn about growing from young to old and how our needs change.

Phonics Screening re-check.

If your child did not pass the phonics screening test at the end of year one, they will be re-tested one day next week. Results will come out on their school reports.

Whitehall
